Impressed with their dedication and commitment above and beyond the call of duty, Paul had further cause to sing their praises: during this period, lain helped the Police locate and arrest

a suspect carrying a firearm who had threatened someone in the town centre. lain has since received a letter of commendation from Nottinghamshire Police as a gesture of thanks for his intervention in what was a very serious incident.

The Profile duo showed great flexibility and resilience while new officers completed their training. Life has since returned to as near as normal for the CCTV team. Mr Crompton added, "I commend the Profile Officers and I am proud to say that these Officers are part of our team at Broxtowe. Thank you lain and Ben!"

A LOOK BEHIND THE SCENES: **CHECK CALLS**

Part and parcel of Profile's roundthe-clock security cover is the job carried out by the team at our Leeds Security Control Room. They are there to make sure no harm comes to the Security Guards looking after our clients' premises.

As part of our routine checks and balances, Security Officers on site make regular, planned phone calls to our Leeds Centre. These are logged and reported as part of our routines, but critically, a missed call will set our back-up plan into action. If the Leeds Centre cannot reach the Security Officer, our Mobile Patrols (or our colleagues in the Police force) will sweep into action to investigate

the reason for the missed call.

Designed to save lives and escalate our emergency response, the Check Call procedure is key to Profile's hands-on 24/7 approach security. Only by making sure nothing has happened to our Guards can we in turn ensure that our clients' premises and the people that visit them remain safe.
