#### TRAGEDY DOWN UNDER

Global operator Stena Drilling had reason to thank Profile Security Officer **Odedairo Akinola** for dealing with a difficult situation few of us are prepared for. Stena's **John Curran** explains: "Shortly after midnight on 27th August, a call came through to our Operations Centre in Aberdeen reporting an incident on the *Stena Clyde*, a semi-submersible rig off the shores of Australia. A tragic accident on the drill floor had resulted in two fatalities.

"Our onshore emergency organisation was immediately mobilised. I would like to commend Odedairo who was on duty at the time. He kept a cool head, put his training into practice and worked through Stena's emergency drill, designed specifically for this kind of emergency."

"Odedairo summoned assistance and was able to pass on all the relevant information to various members of our team in a cool and calm manner. At the end of his shift, he also carried out a detailed handover to the reception staff and myself, making everyone's job a lot easier under very sad and difficult circumstances."

The Management and Staff at Profile Security Services would like to extend their condolences to the friends and families of the two engineers who lost their lives.


#### **KEY MANAGERS MARK DECADE OF SUCCESS**



#### **Door Supervisor Licence - Licence Renewals and Training**

If you currently hold a Door Supervisor Licence and you are looking to renew it, you won't need to re-train if you obtained your qualification after Summer 2010 when the latest qualifications were introduced. **However, if you attained your qualification before that date, you will have to undertake additional compulsory training**.

In the interest of public safety, the additional training (which includes Physical Intervention) will be a compulsory requirement from 4 February 2013.

If you have any questions, please contact your line manager.

DON'T FORGET: it is a requirement under the Private Security Industry Act and the conditions of SIA licensing that you notify the SIA of any change of address.
